A day discovering Reggio Emilia and its artistic beauties, spreading throughout the history and the city.

**Reggio Emilia**, city home of great gastronomic specialties, but also **rich in art and culture**. From one end to the other of the Via Emilia, a journey to discover the artistic works that characterize it, it is waiting for us.

We will reach the prestigious **cloisters of San Pietro**, recently restored to their original splendor, we will walk along the **Via Emilia**, plunging into the Roman era, and upon reaching their destination, we will travel through time to discover one of the **masterpieces of the Renaissance**: "Portrait of a Young Woman" by Correggio, the most famous portrait executed by the artist.

Afterwards, a visit to the exhibition "What a wonderful world" at Palazzo Magnani, built in the 16th century and an important exhibition venue. Here, we will admire examples of **art from around the world** on the **theme of ornament**, discovering how this art has changed into **2000 years of history**.

Among the streets of the historic center we will discover **artisan workshops**, art studios and restoration laboratories; the ancient crafts of art, which preserve the methods and techniques of the ornament **between history and modernity**.

We will have the exclusive opportunity to visit to **the oldest knitwear in Italy**, the **Modateca Deanna**, an atelier that stands out for its continuous search for **innovation and stylistic updating**, with particular attention to beauty, attention to detail, to the ornament, essential elements for the creation of new collections.
